Diamonds are a girl's best friend—but while that priory ice is nice, stars including **Jenna Elfman**, **Claire Forlani** and **Winona Ryder** are finding diamond-shaped patterns equally fun to flaunt. Current updates on age-old argyle "reflect that classic, preppy feeling," says Barbara Benenson, creative director of knitwear maker White & Warren, which features the look. Making their points in slinky leather or silk—like the Stella McCartney Chloé number Elftman sported at a movie premiere—diamond-printed duds "reinvent something traditional," adds New York City stylist Danna Weiss, "but with a slight edge for a younger look." Another fan, JAG's **Catherine Bell**, calls the pattern "very geometric, which makes it fun and kind of funky."

To avoid looking like a harlequin, though, choose your diamonds' size with care. "Take into consideration what is appropriate for your height and body type," advises Benenson. "Wearing anything too bold sends a glaring message." In other words, leave huge diamonds where they belong—on your finger.
